

## **Gatsby Benchmarks**

## What are they?

The statutory guidance from the DfE regarding career related learning (Careers guidance and access for education and training providers, October 2018) has the long term vision for a world class careers provision and states that schools should be using the Gatsby Benchmarks as a framework to develop and improve practice.

There are 8 Benchmarks to work towards -

- 1. A stable careers programme
- 2. Learning from career and labour market information
- 3. Addressing the needs of each pupil
- 4. Linking curriculum learning to careers
- 5. Encounters with employers and employees
- 6. Experiences of workplaces
- 7. Encounters with further and higher education
- 8. Personal guidance

## How we do this

We measure the schools progress on this via the Gatsby Benchmarks compass tool, this allows for regular monitoring and implementation of good practice, this includes contact with an impartial level 6 careers advisor and encounters with employers from year 8.
