

Outcomes statement for the academic year of 2023 - 2024

Overall 61 of the students at Longdon Park took a formal qualification in the academic year 23/24. These qualifications included:

- Entry Levels 1,2 and 3 (20 students) –English, Mathematics, Science, History, Geography and P.E.
- Functional Skills Levels 1 and 2 (19 students) –English and Mathematics.
- GCSEs (19 students) – English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Combined Science, History, Fine Art and R.E.
- AS-Levels and A-Levels (3 students) – English Literature and History.
